a. Candidate Q&A: Peter Leroe-Munoz for Gilroy City Council.

VTA and CalTrain service might be cut, and he would like to try to keep that as well. He is a Democrat. It's a crowded field. There are 3 seats and 7 candidates. He has been endorsed by Forrest Williams, Ash Kalra, some members of Santa Clara Valley Water District, and some past and present city council members. Two incumbents are running against him. Motion to endorse Peter, motion carries. Abstentions: Joseph Sanchez. Andres – San Jose Evergreen Community College Board of Trustees – Area 4, Motion to correct our previous endorsement – motion carries.

#### b. SVYD Latino Outreach Plan discussion

Presented by Omar Torres. Many are worried about Latinos not coming out in November to vote. There is a need to work on voter ID for younger Latinos. Omar, Elias, and Adan are trying to create a Pp presentation to work on recruitment of Latinos to clubs and the Democratic party. They want to focus on immigration, education, and leadership development in hopes of keeping up high turnout from 2008. Most Latinos aren't registered to vote, so we may want to focus on voter registration. The next CYD E-Board meeting will have training for Spanish speaking leaders in the party. It would be helpful to have headquarters located closer to Spanish speaking areas. Creation of more Latino alliance coalitions would help. This club and others may want to establish a position on this issue. Creating Spanish literature or English/Spanish literature could be part of the project too. Making partnership with PACT or other faith organizations. This will be an ongoing effort, that won't stop after November. Swanee opening office in South County that we can use to reach Latino voters. Currently working with Chris Riley and EQCA. Make video rather than Pp. Conversation to be continued. Send suggestions to Omar.
