Assemblymember Bob Wieckowski was re-elected November 2012 to represent the 25th Assembly District in the California Legislature. The district stretches from southern Alameda County into Milpitas, San Jose and Santa Clara in Santa Clara County. The district shares his focus on job creation, clean technologies, protecting our environment and reducing economic hardships.

Assemblymember Wieckowski has launched the Made in California Jobs Initiative to expand California manufacturing, invest in biotechnology research, and fight for small businesses. He has also introduced the Student Bill of Rights bill package, aimed at addressing the growing student debt crisis.

In his first term in office, he had 21 bills signed into law by Governor Brown. Reflecting his collaborative style, most of these bills were approved with strong, bipartisan support. His hard work was recognized by Tech America, which declared him a "Technology Champion."

Mr. Wieckowski previously served as Vice Mayor of the City of Fremont. He remains a small business owner and a bankruptcy attorney, in which he has helped hundreds of families and seniors through economic hardship. He received his B.A. from the University of California and his J.D. from Santa Clara University Law School. Assemblymember Wieckowski lives in Fremont with Sue Lemke, and her son Luke.
